## The Shelburne Falls Loop







## How were these popularity ratings calculated?

A motorcycle road's popularity can be based on a wide variety of factors. For the sake of being consistent and as objective as possible, we looked at a number of diverse factors including the route's "Rider Rating" score and then a number of computer tracked enthusiasm indicators (ex. number of page-views, comments, photos, videos, etc.). All of these come together in a mathematical formula to produce an overall popularity rating. In the end, we know there is no perfect method for calculating this however we at least hope you will find our approach to be logical, consistent & reasonable.

Note 1: US Regions are defined by the official US Census Bureau which designate the states in the Northeast as Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Rhode Island, Pennsylvania, and Vermont.

With every year's summary list I produce, I get my share of comments & complaints from riders who believe they know of a better route or two that didn't make the list or wasn't ranked as high as they wanted. That's a fair response as I realize there are always more great routes out there to discover ... what I ask however is if MotorcycleRoads.com is missing a great route, please add the route to MotorcycleRoads.com. Or if a current route on the site is underrated, please add comments, pictures or videos explaining this and the route will begin to climb in the rankings.
